



WHAT IS THE SDCA SCRIP PROGRAM?

- Our Scrip Program has been running since 1993.
- Scrip Sales are held at the office on Scrip Days.
- Scrip purchases are optional, but everybody contributes to our Scrip program. A \$50 Scrip deposit per student is charged at registration. The deposit will be fully refunded after an eligible amount of Scrip purchase is made. For the 1st child in the family \$700, 2nd child \$600, and \$500 for each of the remaining children in the family. You have the entire school year to reach the goal.
- Upon fulfillment, refund in Scrip of your choice(s) may be picked up from the office on any Scrip Day.

HOW DOES THE SDCA SCRIP FUNDRAISING PROGRAM WORK?

- The Scrip fundraising works like this: families in our school order gift cards through our Scrip program and pay face value, and we buy the gift cards from our Scrip supplier, or directly from our local retailers, for a lesser amount. Our school keeps the difference, called a rebate, and we use the funds we raise from Scrip to sponsor various school activities.
- Basically, families are able to fundraise for our school just by using gift cards for their shopping, instead of credit cards or cash.
- We are able to order gift cards for most national retailers, and a few local businesses. We sell from an inventory of more than 20 different gift cards, ranging from grocery, department stores, dining, home décor, clothing, books, and entertainment to health/beauty.

WHAT IS SCRIP FOR? WHAT DO THE FUNDS GO TOWARD?

- All Scrip Sale profits are used to sponsor school activities, such as seminars, Chinese New Year Carnival, volunteer party, anniversary celebrations etc. They are also used to provide gifts, awards, and teachers' snacks.
